GENERAL INFORMATION & RULES OF THE OIL RANCH

By entering the ranch, you are in agreement that all rules on this page must be followed, along with any additional rules posted throughout the ranch.

- Minors MUST always be accompanied by an adult and actively supervised. Children will not be allowed to participate at an activity station without an adult present.
- This is a real working ranch. Please tell us immediately if you see anything dangerous, or anything that needs immediate attention.
- Unlimited visits to any activity; however, no saving space or cutting in line.
- Please do not pick up or chase the animals.
- · No smoking allowed inside the Oil Ranch.
- Food/drinks may be brought into the Ranch on the WEEKDAYS (No glass or alcohol allowed). Coolers are subject to search. ONLY bottled water is allowed to be brought in on the WEEKENDS.
- Service Dogs are allowed. Emotional Support Animals must have documentation. No pets allowed.
- Guests may eat at the YO Pavilion (in any area not reserved).
- Our First Aid Station is located at the General Store. Please notify an Oil Ranch Team Member if you're in need of medical attention.
- · Drinking fountains are located by the lake restroom facility.
- Wagons (located by the front ticket house) may be used for free for 15 minutes, or can be rented for the day for \$10.00. Please return wagons to the front after using.
- Any activity may be closed at any time for construction, safety, or other reasons.
- Please remember to disinfect hands after touching the animals.
 Sanitizer pumps are located throughout the ranch.
- Caution: We have areas throughout the ranch that may contain several allergens such as hay, milk, eggs, peanuts, wheat, etc.

 Please use caution if you have a medical condition that could be affected by exposure to these allergens.

ACTIVITIES FOR EVERYONE



- <u>COW POKE PONY RIDES:</u> For children 12 & under. Ponies are hand-led by an Oil Ranch Team Member. Children must be accompanied by an adult. One rider at a time. Please.....only Oil Ranch Team Members in the pony arena.
- PETTING ZOO: For all ages everyone gets to go inside! Remember......Please Do Not Pick Up or Chase the Animals!
- DAIRY BARN: An educational exhibit showcasing modern day milking procedures. This includes the process of taking the milk from the dairy to you. An Oil Ranch Team Member will assist you in milking the cow. Be sure to disinfect hands both before and after.
- <u>BIG BARN</u>: Have fun playing in the big pile of hay, sliding down the slide, and visiting all the animals. Remember......Please Do Not Pick Up or Chase the Animals! <u>Caution: This area may contain several allergens such as hay, milk, eggs, peanuts, wheat, etc. Please use caution if you have a medical condition that could be affected by exposure to these allergens.</u>
- <u>TUMBLEWEED RACERS:</u> Take a roll in our giant Tumbleweed Wheels. No more than 2 people in each wheel. See if you can make it turn like a tumbleweed! Please be mindful of those outside the wheel. Do not stand in front of or behind the wheel. Do not push from the outside.
- <u>KID HOPPER:</u> Enjoy our in-ground jumping pillow. Shoes, watches, and jewelry must be removed. Socks are recommended while jumping. Must be physically fit, no somersaults, and absolutely no jumping when Oil Ranch Team Member is not present. No jumping when wet.
- HAY RIDE: Hand feed the cattle in the pasture. Do not exit the wagon without the permission of the driver. All guest must remain seated while wagon is in motion.....DO NOT SIT ON THE RAILING. <u>Caution:</u> The hayride route may contain rough terrain, please use caution if you are pregnant or have a physical/medical condition that could be affected by this ride.
- TRAIN RIDE: Take a ride on the Oil Ranch Express. Riders must stay seated and keep arms & legs inside the
 train at all times. Do not exit train car until the train has come to a complete stop. PLEASE do not walk on
 or across the train tracks.
- <u>SPRING CREEK MINING:</u> Panning for gemstones & fossils is fun for all ages!!! You can purchase the mining rough at the General Store.
- PAINTBALL SHOOTING GALLERY: Target shooting for all ages! Remember......please actively supervise
 your children. Eye protection must always be worn in this area. Paintball tickets are for sale at the
 Shooting Gallery or at the General Store.
- STOCKYARD MAZE: Walk through the Stockyard Maze and see if you recognize the six flags over Texas!
- FRONTIER VILLAGE: Explore and play among the Teepees, the Sky Swing, and Charlotte's Web. See if you can ring the bell at the top of the Lil' Brave Rope Climb!
- <u>WILD WEST PUTT PUTT:</u> Enjoy playing 9 holes of golf! Balls & clubs provided please return them before leaving the area. Putt please! Swinging clubs can be dangerous and destructive to others and the course. Please wait to start a hole until the players ahead have finished.
- <u>PLAYGROUNDS:</u> Swings, Slides, Softball, Soccer, Volleyball, Basketball, Tug-O-War, Sack Races & Horseshoes are activities located around the ranch. <u>Remember......Please actively supervise your children.</u>
- FISHING: Fun for the whole family! Catch & release fishing. Bring your own bait, tackle, and pole.
- <u>SWIMMING POOL:</u> Seasonal activity. Our swimming pool is for everyone! Bring swimsuit & towel. No regular clothes allowed in pool. Remember......Please actively supervise your children.
- PADDLE BOATS: Waiver must be signed. One rider must be at least 18 years of age with a government issued photo ID. Up to 4 riders per boat. Children must be able to sit on their own. All riders must wear a life vest (life vest provided). No fishing allowed from the paddle boats, and no swimming in the lake.
